

WHAT WILL YOU SAY...

Yes, I have a third conundrum to answer. Reach the right somebody, verbalize correct passwords and so get briefing.

A to N are regulars. X is a person, Y is an object and Z is a place - usually a planet or a ship. X, Y and Z are the same thing within each individual entry, but different things in different entries. You want the episode titles (but ignore all spaces.) It's as easy as pie...

1. X offers B the Y in exchange for J. B flies down with C and J. M plans a double-cross to get both Y and J.
2. A delivers medicine to Z but M and N are waiting. A eventually obtains J which predicts the end of K.

11. M releases plague on Z, homeworld of F. F's twin sends a message.
12. A decides to destroy Z, but M and N are waiting for him. E is killed.
13. A has flashbacks. X offers plan to A but B doesn't believe him.
14. A wants to destroy Z but B argues. A is wounded, B kills N and D sends warning.
15. X persuades M to let him try to capture K. G decides to raid Z but this may be X's plan.
16. F is killed in explosion. I and X take B, C, G and H to L.
17. On Z, A, D and F look for X while B and C use J to win. M and N plot against each other.
18. A, B and D take over K. They go to Z to save C and E.
19. A follows clues left by X to try to find Z. B destroys N's ship but N isn't on board.

We have just received this anonymous communication. We believe that it holds an important clue to the code needed to defuse the bomb. Obviously, time is of the essence.
